should only be drunk wearing a sassy smile and killer heels. wyborowa vodka, cointreau, fresh lime, lemon and cranberry juice. shaken, then dramatically finished with flamed orange oils

havana daquiri

a favourite from the '40s. havana club especial with your choice of flavoured liqueur (strawberry, raspberry, peach or blackberry) mixed with fresh lemon, lime juice and sugar

manhattan £9.00

take a walk on the wry side and spend some time with a smart-talking manhattan. a double measure of rye whiskey, stirred with a dash of angostura and your choice of sweet or dry vermouth

margarita

party people the world over know how to shake the place up. they're the ones wielding a margarita. el jimador tequila shaken with cointreau, fresh lemon and lime juice finished off with a salt rim

negroni

beefeater gin stirred with campari and martini rosso. soda is optional

old fashioned £9.00

slow down sonny, pull up a chair, linger awhile and reflect on days gone by. a double measure of bourbon, patiently stirred with brown sugar and orange bitters

rusty nail £9.00

hit the nail on the head with this hammer of a drink. Jamesons whiskey stirred together with drambuie

singapore sling

more than refreshing. a wallop of beefeater gin shaken with giffard cherry brandy and fresh lemon juice. topped up with soda water

sours

your choice of either scotch, amaretto or midori shaken vigorously with cointreau, fresh lemon juice and egg white
